

UNIVERSITY OF KELANIYA VACANCIES

POST OF CHIEF MARSHAL

The University of Kelaniya, Sri Lanka will entertain applications for the **post of Chief Marshal** from suitably qualified persons up to **17.05.2024**.

Required Qualifications:

1. A holder of the post of Deputy Chief Marshal in the Marshal service in the university system and confirmed in that post with not less than five (05) years of satisfactory service in that grade.

Physique Height 5'.5'' Chest 32" deflated

Note: Preference will be given to those with actively participated in sports activities, Social welfare activities and recreation programmes within the University and at the National level.

OR

2. An Officer not below the rank of Lieutenant Colonel in Sri Lanka Armed Forces / equivalent rank in Sri Lanka Police with active participation in sports activities.

SALARY SCALE - U-EX 2 (II)

- Rs. 66,180 8x1335; 8x1630 89,900 p.m. and salary will be paid accordingly to the University Grants Commission Circular No. 17/2016 (V) dated 01.06.2018.
- In addition, cost of living allowance and other UGC approved allowances will be paid to selected candidate.
- Approximately gross salary would be around LKR 131,000.00.

CONDITIONS OF SERVICE:

1. This Post is permanent. The appointment will be probation for a period of three (03) years.

- 2. Selected candidates, if presently serving in Government Departments will have to obtain their release through the Ministry of Public Administration. Government servants will not be entitled to maintain their pension rights whilst in the University Service.
- 3. Selected candidates, will become contributors to the Universities provident Fund by means of monthly deductions from his/her salary an amount equal to ten (10%) percentum of his/her earnings. The University will, in addition out of its funds contribute at the same time a sum equal to seven (7%) percentum of his/her earnings to the Universities Provident Fund, eight (8%) percentum of his/her earnings to the Pension Fund and three (3%) percentum of his/her earnings to the Employees Trust Fund (ETF).
- 4. Appointees to the permanent posts will become members of the Universities Pension Scheme.
- 5. Other conditions of appointment will be in accordance with the provisions of the Universities Act No. 16 of 1978 and subsequent amendments and Ordinances, Regulations, Rules, etc., made thereunder.
- 6. Applicants from the University System/Government Departments/Corporations and Statutory Boards should apply through the Heads of their respective Institutions.

AGE

- Age should be not less than 18 years and not more than 45 years.
- Age limit of Public Officers & Local Government Officers should not more than 55 years.

METHOD OF RECRUITMENT

- Selection by a structured Interview.
- Applicants who have scored 40% marks or above at the structured interview are eligible to be considered for selection.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

Duly completed applications should be forwarded under the registered post with certified copies of all relevant certificates to be considered (Educational, Professional, Service and Extra-curricular Activities, etc.) to reach the **Deputy Registrar**, **Academic Establishment Division**, **University of Kelaniya**, **Dalugama**, **Kelaniya** on or before **17.05.2024**. The post applied for should be indicated on the left-hand corner of the envelope. Applications sent in the specified format will only be accepted.
